'Be Safe, Be Fair, Behave'

Morning	Drop Off Zone	• Parking permitted up to 8:30am • No parking (leaving the car unattended) after 8:30am • 8:30am onwards to be used as kiss and drop area only
	Car Park	• Parking permitted up to 8:30am • No parking after 8:30am • Parking is permitted if parents have an ill sibling in the car or other medical reasons. • Parking is permitted on rare occasion when you are running late. This should be once or twice a year, NOT ONCE OR TWICE A WEEK! • Disabled bays can be used at all times for any driver with a disabled badge
After School	Drop Off Zone	• No parking (leaving the car unattended) between 3:00pm and 4:00pm • Drivers to stay in the car when using this area between 3:00pm and 4:00pm • Parking permitted after 4:00pm • Keep the main vehicular entrance clear to enable cars and buses to pull in off the road
	Car Park	• No parking (leaving the car unattended) between 3:00pm and 4:00pm • Parents to pull into a car park space and wait in the car if the drop off zone is full • Parking is permitted if parents have an ill sibling in the car or other medical reasons. • Disabled bays can be used at all times for any driver with a disabled badge
